The Christadelphians in Bramerton have a large collection of historic Bibles including facsimiles of very rare Bibles many hundreds of years old. We would like those that live in our locality to have the opportunity to see this very interesting collection. The Bibles will be on display at the above venue and admission is free. So please come and look and learn more about this amazing book, the Bible.

Also on display for a short while (see times below) will be the Norwich Apocalypse and the Boleyn Wycliffe Bible which are part of a collection owned by The Norfolk Heritage Centre at the Millennium Library. The Apocalypse is beautifully illustrated and dates back to the mid-1200s. The Wycliffe Bible is handwritten and inside is written “liber Iacobi Boolene manens in Blickling” or “James Boleyn’s book dwelling in Blickling.” Sir James Boleyn was Anne Boleyn’s uncle.


